Render 2416 of Gobarro continued

Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County the 26th day of March Anno Dom 1697 that he take Amos Chadburn and Mary his wife Adm^r of William Jones if they should be found in his Bailiwick and them safe keep so that he have their Bodies before his Maj^{ty} Justices Justices at the next Court to Answer unto Simon Wilmer of a plea of Trover upon the rap
At which Court viz: the 22th day of June Anno Dom 1697
Came Capt. Edward Swatnam High Sheriff of said County being the day of returns of the writt and made returns thereof in these words, viz: Capi Corpora & Edw: Swatnam thoff

On which day came the sd Defend^t and J Richard Marklyntier Attorney and appeared and prayed thereof to be put off until the next Court which was granted the said day was given to the plet likewise

And now here at this day viz: the 25th day of August Anno Dom 1697 came as well the plet by W^m Hornsloy his Attorney as also the said Defend^t J Richard Marklyntier his Attorney and the said cause standing now for trial

Simon Wilmer plet

Amos Chadburn et ux or Adm^r of W^m Jones det } Kent J Amos Chadburn and Mary his wife Adm^r of William Jones case of Ed + County Dorset who did Intestate as his said stand Attended to Answer unto Simon Wilmer of a plea of Trover upon the case
And whereupon the said Simon by W^m Hornsloy his Attorney complaineth that whereas the said W^m Jones on the 26th day of March Anno Dom 1696 in the County within the Parish of St Martin in London thousand seven fifty and One pound and half a pound of Gold and Merchantable Gobarro in cash being the Ballance of Account the particulars thereof here in Court brought in consideration whereof the said William upon himselfe assumed and to the sd Simon he faithfully promised that he the sd William the sd Sum of 775 1/2 pounds of Gobarro unto the sd Simon would well and truly pay when thereunto required
