

And whereas the sd Rematur Smith by Richard Marklein his Attorney complaineth that whereas Jonathan King of the County Pleinor goodlyly indebted to the sd Rematur the full and just sum of four hundred pounds of good lawfull Merchables Tobacco in cash and the sd Jonathan being indebted as aforesd the sd William to wit the 10th day of March Anno Dom 1696 in the County within the Jurisdiction of this Court in consideration and at the especial instance and request of him the sd William that if the sd Rematur would discharge him the sd Jonathan of and from the sd Debt of 400^l of Tobacco and take him the sd William for the sum of 400^l of Tobacco as aforesd that then he the sd William upon himself assumed and to the sd Rematur faithfully promised that he the sd William the sd sum of 400^l of Tobacco into the sd Rematur would well and truly pay when the same required And the sd Rematur in full faith that he trusting to the promise and assumption aforesd of him the sd William did discharge him the sd Jonathan of and from the sd sum of four hundred pounds of Tobacco as aforesd Yet notwithstanding the sd William the sum of 400^l of Tobacco according to his promise and assumption aforesd into the sd Rematur he hath not paid but the said to him he hath denied and refused and still doth deny and refuse to pay the same and the damage of him the sd Rematur 800^l of Tobacco and more upon the breach of this suit Marklein of: pldges: de: Rich Lee

to which the Defond^r Attorney plead, Non sum informaty thereupon the Pet by Richard Marklein his Attorney prayeth he may have Judgment awarded comfort to his Declaration which is accordingly granted

And here it is considered by this Court that the Pet Rematur Smith doe recover from the Defond^r William Sicyes as well the sum of four hundred pounds of Tobacco as also the sum of two hundred thirty and seven pounds of Tobacco cost of suit
