to be paid unto the sd Pet^t their certain Attorney Ex^d or Offi-
cer the sd sum of 2416 of Tobacco qualified as aforesd
yest nevertheles^s the sd Edward the sd sum of 2416 pounds
of Tobacco according to the form^r of the same Bill unto the
sd Pet^t he hath not paid all the often demanded but the sum
to pay he hath denied and refused to the damages of the sd Pet^t
four thousand pounds of Tobacco used thereupon he bring^s
his suit Honiflow P^r of^r Pedger & John Doe
Rich Roe

and Briony of and the said defendt by Richard his
Atty's cause of the Bill
which being heard the defendant by Richard Marlein his Atty
desireth to say and for cause of remitter saith that the action
