 And dated this twenty-fifth day of August Anno Domini 1685

The condition of this obligation is such that if the said John
 Lee his heirs executors and Assigns and
 every of them do & shall well & truly performe and paye all
 the duty the said Shewards grants Conditions & Agreements what
 soever mentioned & comprised in one or more Indentures bearing
 date wth these Writs & made between a certain certain John
 Lee his wife & one part and a certain certain
 John Lee his wife & one part & a certain certain
 John Lee his heirs executors administrators and assigns
 to be performed and kept according to the true intent and meaning
 of the said Indentures then this obligation to be void otherwise
 to continue & remaine in full force & virtue
