At which Court viz: the 24th day of August Anno Dom 1697
 the day of Return of sd Britt James Capt. Edward Swatnam
 High Sheriff of the County and under return of sd Britt in these
 Words viz: (Capi Corpus) Et sic: Invenimus eum

In which day came the sd Defend^t by Michael Lard his Attorney
 and pray on there of to have a writ of Habeas Corpus which was granted
 the same day as given to the Pet likewise

And then heard at this day viz: the 28th day of September Anno
 Dom 1697 the sd cause standing for Trial at the Pet: not necessary
 need the Declaration the Defend^t Thomas Jee by Michael Lard his
 Attorney moved this Court for a Non suit which it accordingly granted

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the Defend^t Thomas
 Jee doe Recover from the Pet William Denton as well the sum of
 fifty pounds of Tobacco for a Non suit as also the sum of
 one hundred fifty and eight pounds of Tobacco cost of suit
