and that he provided he made not his personal appearance
at the next Carl County Court then and there to answer
such matters as shall be objected at him on his Majesty's behalf
to which he gave his consent

Hugh Marsh acknowledgeth himself indebted to our
Sovereign Lord the King in the sum of five pounds sterling money
of England to be levied on his lands and to none other
and that he provided Thomas Burk did not make his personal
appearance at the next Carl County Court then and there
to answer unto such matters as shall be objected at him on his
Majesty's behalf and in the meantime be of good behavior
to all his Majesty's good people to which he gave his consent

John Robinson being summoned to this Court to give an
account he holds the Estate of the Orphan of Robert
Hobbs

Ordered that the said John Robinson bring the said Orphan
to the next Court next that the Justices may take such care of the
Orphan as his reparity and Estate shall require and to them it
shall seem meet
