

This Indenture made y^e thirtieth Day of January 1634 in the
 14th year of the Dominion of Charles Absolute Lord & Proprietary of the
 Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. Between
 Dennis of Kent County in y^e County of Maryland on the one
 part and John Rods of y^e County of the other part Witnesseth
 That y^e said Dennis hath hereby acknowledged for us in
 relation of y^e sum of five hundred & four hundred pounds of tobacco
 due to him in hand payd by the said John Rods at before y^e day
 of the said day of the said day & truly paid or secured to be paid
 & acknowledged y^e said Dennis hath hereby acknowledged himselfe
 to be every part & parcel thereof fully satisfied contented and
 free of every part & parcel thereof both hereby absolutely &
 acquitt & discharged y^e said John Rods his heirs executors & adminis-
 trators by the said Dennis have given granted bargained & alienated
 confirmed & confirmed: And by the said Dennis hath fully paid
 absolutely and granted bargained & alienated confirmed
 into the said John Rods his heirs & executors & Administrators
 under all that tract or tract of Land which he now lying in
 County of y^e North side of Chester River & on y^e east side of
 called Dennis Woods beginning at a marked white oak stand
 point at y^e mouth of y^e Creek & running up y^e River south
 hundred paces to another marked oak & with y^e line
 oak North east three hundred & twenty paces and
 from y^e end of the North east line North west
 into Dennis Woods bounded on y^e west by y^e Creek to
 oak on y^e South by y^e River containing & layd out for
 Acres more or less together with all & singular the rights
 & appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining
 & all other things whosoever or maner whosoever
 appertaining or concerning y^e premises or any part or parts
 thereof & to hold y^e said tract of Land with y^e rights
 & appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining
 or to any part or parts thereof unto the said
 John Rods his heirs executors Administrators &c. & his
 assigns That y^e said tract of Land with all other
 therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining shall be
 held against all manner of persons whatsoever claiming by
