At which Court viz: the 24th day of August Anno Domini 1697 the Day of Return of the writ came Capt: Edward Swademan high Sheriff of the County and made return of the writ in these words viz: Copi & Pet: Swademan the ff

On which day the said Edward: by W^m Ham: by his Att: appeared and prayed that he might be until next Court which was granted the same day is given to the Pet likewise

Which said cause being continued from Court to Court until this present day

And now heard at this day viz: the 24th day of November Anno Domini 1697 the said cause standing for trial came the said Pet by Sam: Withers his Attorney and declared as the said Pet
