owed and from him they unjustly detain

And whereupon the sd Hugh by Richard Marklin his Attorney
complains and saith that whereas the sd Defond^t by their certain
writing obligatory sealed with the seal of the sd Defond^t at their
art and doct^r delibered and brought into Court whose date is
the said day and year to wit on the 4th day of May Anno Domⁱ
1645 in sd County within the Jurisdiction of this Court did acknowledge
themselves to be holden and firmly bound unto the sd Hugh Marsh
then of Talbot County in the sum of One Hundred thousand
pounds of Tobacco qualified as afores^d to be paid unto the sd
Hugh Marsh or his certain Attorney W^m Don^o or Assign^{ee} to which
payment the sd Defond^t did bind themselves their Heirs Ex^{rs} and Adm^{rs}
to wit: Yet notwithstanding the sd Defond^t the sd sum of 100000
pounds according to the Con^{ts} of the said obligation unto the sd
Hugh Marsh they have not paid altho often demanded but the said
to say they have done and still do deny and refuse to the damage of
the sd Hugh Marsh Two Hundred thousand pounds of Tobacco and thereupon
he brings this suit Marklin q^d p^{ro} p^{ro} q^d in Doe Rich: Roe
