

Richard Chapman and for the debt of him the said Richard
 Chapman by and certain bill or writing obligatory of and unto
 bound and obliged together with him the said Richard to a cer-
 tain John Finnett in the sum of Eleven hundred pounds
 of Tobacco to be paid to him the said John Finnett upon the 10th
 day of October then next ensuing the date of the said bill
 in consideration thereof the aforesaid Richard on the 24th day of
 August 1695 at Salvo County aforesaid did upon him selfe &
 assume to him the said Edward did then and there faithfully pro-
 mise that he the said Richard the said Edward from the said bill
 or writing obligatory and of and from the said 1100 of Tobacco
 in the said Bill contained and also from all suit att Law & expen-
 ses the said John Finnett would discharge and save harmless & yet
 notwithstanding the aforesaid Richard Chapman her promise and assumption
 aforesaid little weighing or regarding but plotting contriving &
 fraudulently intending him the said Edward in that behalf craft-
 ily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid 1100 of Tobacco
 unto the said John Finnett he hath not paid nor him the said Edward in
 any manner by him the said John Finnett of the aforesaid sum of
 1100 of Tob: according to his promise and assumption aforesaid &
 hath not hitherto discharged or saved harmless altho the said Edward
 hath many times requested the said Richard to pay the said sum
 of Tobacco unto the said John Finnett And the said Edward in fact hath
 that by reason of the said Richard's failure of payment of the aforesaid sum
 of 1100 of Tobacco unto the said John Finnett the said John Finnett at
 Salvo County hath sued the said Edward in the said County Court for the
 sum of 1100 of Tobacco for which the said Edward was bound to the
 Richard unto the said John Finnett and hath recovered the same against
 him the said Edward together with 268 of Tobacco cost of suit by
 the said Court adjudged whereby Action did accrue to the said Edward
 to have & require from the said Richard the like sum of 1468 of Tobacco
 being the aforesaid Debt and cost of suit Yet notwithstanding the said
 Richard the said sum of 1468 of Tobacco the Debt and cost aforesaid
 altho often demanded unto the said Edward hath not paid but y-
 et came to pay he hath denied and refused & yet doth deny and refuse to the
 damages of the said Edward 2000 of Tob: and thereupon he brings this suit
