their atty complain that Whereas the said Hugh on the 18th day
of October Anno Dom 1697 at Choper River within the Juris-
diction of this Court stood justly indebted unto them the sd Sarah
Daniel and John the full and just value of Ann Throford p^{ts}
of Tobacco or the value thereof in Wheat and Indian Corn to wit
Wheat at fifty pounds of Tobacco & Bushel and Indian H
Corn at twenty pounds of Tobacco & Bushel it being
the third payment to be made by him the said Hugh unto
them
