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And now here at this day came the sd Edward Grey
to answer the sd indictment: which being read into an
indictment: is as followeth:

The Jurors for our Sovereign Lord the King of Kent
County upon their Oath do present Edward Grey otherwise
called Edward Grey of the County of Inghelore for that he the sd
Edward on the 2^d day of November Anno Domini 1647
at Chester London remained in the County within the Juris-
diction of this Court the Lord day lawfully called
Sunday did abuse and prophane by knowingly and will-
fully suffering and permitting at his house Richards Hall
to stay Tipling and Drunkenness to the great dishonor of
Allmighty God and scandal of Christian Religion at
the presence of our sd Lord the King and at the Act of
Assembly in that respect made and provided

To which sd indictment the sd Edward Grey pleaded not guilty
and for Trial put himself upon the Country

And the King in like manner Marked
Command was therefore given to the Sheriff of Kent
County that he cause indicted goods and Lawfull men of
his County to be that they do and appear before his
Court to be of good name &c. which Jury are viz:
