 making any other defence but are willing that Judgmt.  
 shall be awarded for the sum of 2200 of Tobacco & cap

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the said William  
 Bentley doth recover from the Defend: Thomas Gore as much  
 the aforesd sum of two thousand two hundred pounds  
 of Tobacco as well as the sum of two hundred fifty and  
 fifteen pounds of Tobacco rest of suit
