And now here at this day the 2d day of January for cause  
named the tff Pet by Richard Mervin his Attorney and  
Dolary of Ed.

That Ed. Mervin and his wife Edw. of the said  
will and Testament of Phillip Davis late of Ed County Esq.  
and attorney to Anspur unto H<sup>r</sup> Pet of a sum of  
Fifty pds upon the case

And whereupon the tff William by Richard Mervin his  
att<sup>r</sup> complaineth that whereas the tff Phillip in his life  
time viz: on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December Anno Domini 1691  
at Chester River in Ed County within the Jurisdiction of this  
Court goodly money to the tff H<sup>r</sup> Pet in the full sum of  
sum of four hundred pounds of Tobacco it being  
for an attorney fee in the Provincial Court for impleading  
one Robert Allen Morrison and the suit of him the said  
Phillip in consideration whereof the tff Phillip upon him-  
selfe agreed and to the tff William faithfully promised  
that the tff Phillip the tff sum of 400 of Tobacco  
and the same before named well and truly paid when  
presented: and whereas it doth appear from the tff Phillip the aforesd  
sum of 400 of Tobacco according to his promise and the  
Assumption in his life time unto the tff H<sup>r</sup> Pet he did not pay  
to the defendant whose sole and unmarried son the tff Edw: and  
Suzanne his first wife married nor either of them in  
their several separations because they had not been able  
to find money to pay the same to each other because the tff  
Edw: and Suzanne were not able to have the means of  
paying the same and the tff Phillip had
