

In 20th year of a certain Act of Afford Beg. did carry the said

Which reason being argued and by this Court considered this  
Court doo give Judgment: that the said demurrer is good in Law  
& that the said Defd. have a Non Suit  
Therefore it is considered by this Court that the Defend<sup>t</sup>  
William Nelson at Elford doo Remove from the plt John &  
Pomberton as well the sum of fifty pounds of Gobard  
for a Non Suit as alsoe the sum of two hundred and four  
pounds of Gobard cost of suit

at Dover in the presence of the Justices of the Peace  
of the County of Kent &c.
