

Commaund was given to y^e Sheriff of Kent County the 22th day
 of November Anno Domini 1697 that by good and Lawfull men
 of his Bailiwick to make knowne unto James Conway sed
 that he do and appears before his Ma^{ty} Justice at the next
 Court to show cause why Execution should not issue again
 for 16th of Tobacco or Security for John Case

At which Court viz: the 15th day of Feb^r Anno Domini 1697
 the day before Journall of sd Court came Capt Edward Swatman
 next Sheriff of sd County and made returns of sd writ in
 these words viz: made knowne to the within James Conway
 before Simon Wilmer one W^m Smith that he do and appe^r
 the next Court to show cause why Execution should not issue
 again for the within mentioned sum^{me} of Tobacco of
 Edw: Swatman Sheriff

On which day the sd James Conway in his proper person
 appeared but shew no cause why the said should not be
 Executione Executi^o awarded for the sum of 16th of Tobacco

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the sd Willm
 Miller have Execution at the sd James Conway for the
 sum of sixteen hundred and Eighteen pound of Tobacco
