 doth God by this Court to be twenty years of age and
 to serve according to Act of Assembly in that respect made &
 provided *Wilmers etc*

Command was given to the Sheriff of West County the 23rd day
 of June Anno Dom 1697 that he take James Williams if he
 should be found in the Bailiwick and him safe keep so that
 he shall see his Body before his Maj^{ties} Justice at the next Court
 to answer unto Thomas Bauff of a plea that he send unto him
 12th of October

At which Court viz the 27th day of August Anno Dom 1697
 the day of return of sd Writt unto Cap^t Edward Swatnam High
 Sheriff of sd County and made return of sd Writt in these words
 viz Cap^t Edward Swatnam Sheriff

On which day said the sd Defendant by Richard Marston Ser^t
 atty and App^r and prayer thereof to be enlarged until the next Court
 which was granted the same day is given to the pet^r likewise

Which said writt being confirmed from Court to Court until the
 next day

And now here at this day the said James Williams for himself and
 the sd James by Marston Ser^t atty for all the sd Defendant
 doth shew and sheweth that he is not bound
