charge who withdrew and after some time did againe. It  
returne and being called over according to the writen Panel  
as attor the pet and defend: doo say they find for the Defend  
Whereupon the sd Defend: by his said Attorney moves this Court  
for a Non suit which is accordingly granted

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the Defend: James  
Williams doo Recover from the pet Thomas Burrell with the  
sume of fifty pounds of Tobacco for a Non suit as attor  
the sume of Six hundred and fourty pounds of Tobacco  
cost of suit

Command was given to the Sherif of Kent County the 23<sup>th</sup> day  
of June Anno Dom 1697 that he take James Williams if he should  
be found in his Bailiwick and him safe keep soe that he  
have his Body before his Mas<sup>ty</sup> Justice at the next Court to  
Answer unto Thomas Burrell of a plea that he deliver One  
gray Mare

Which said stay being returned from Court to Court  
until the plaintiff can and recover all his say: the  
said Burrell, or the said James Williams
