At which Court was the 26<sup>th</sup> day of April anno Dom: 1698  
the day by adjournment of returned of Ed Britt and  
Capt Edward Sroatman theye Sheriff of Ed County and it  
was returned of Ed Britt in his Board of Esq: Nihil  
*Edw: Sroatman. Htff*

And the Edt by Richard Marchant his Atty: in aboynting it  
appaerd that there was the second Britt on which the Sheriff  
had made a paine returned now of this Court for an attachment  
it was accordingly granted

Sirion Wilmer haue attachment as the debts of sum:
