And the p<sup>ty</sup> Henry by William Harrieff his attorney complains  
 and saith y<sup>t</sup> the p<sup>ty</sup> Benja Ricard y<sup>e</sup> Testator in his life time  
 the two or twentieth day of April 1644 did by his  
 certain writing under the hand of him the p<sup>ty</sup> Benja  
 cause himself to be bound to him y<sup>e</sup> Henry in the first  
 sume of seven hundred thirty four pounds of tobacco  
 yet the p<sup>ty</sup> Benja the Testator nor Elizabeth the Ex<sup>or</sup>  
 the afores<sup>d</sup> sume hath not redem<sup>d</sup> but the same to pay  
 hath denyed and as yet doth deny to the damage of the  
 Henry Heaver two thousand pounds of tobacco and  
 there upon he bringeth this Plea Harrieff p<sup>ty</sup>

And the p<sup>ty</sup> Eliza in her p<sup>pr</sup> person comes and defendeth  
 the force and injury & and for plea saith that the said  
 Henry his own ag<sup>t</sup> her ought not to have for y<sup>e</sup> the  
 way nor at that time of taking out the Originall writ she  
 not admitted Ex<sup>or</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> deceased of this side Remand  
 Judgment of this worshipfull Courtt by y<sup>e</sup> J<sup>st</sup> Lethbridge Harris

The Courtt having considered y<sup>e</sup> Issues found to find in y<sup>e</sup>  
 y<sup>e</sup> as to the matter on y<sup>e</sup> Defendants will was granted to  
 y<sup>e</sup> the p<sup>ty</sup> Henry y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>ty</sup> Eliza's originall writ y<sup>e</sup> for the  
 award Judgment for y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>ty</sup> Henry for seven hundred thirty  
 four pounds of tobacco & cost of suit &c

Therefore it is considered by this Courtt that y<sup>e</sup> Henry  
 shall recover from y<sup>e</sup> Testator out of y<sup>e</sup> Estate of  
 the sum of seven hundred thirty four pounds  
 of tobacco & cost of suit &c
