

Wherefore it is considered by this Court that the said
Robert Norroft doo recover from the said Christopher
Bennet as well the summe of fifty poundes of Tobacco
for a Non suit as all for the sume of Eight Hundred fifty
and six poundes of Tobacco cost of suit

Command was given to the Sherif of Kent County the 2th
day of November Anno Dom 1697 to take William Evans if
he should be found in his Bailiwick and him safe to keepe
soe that he have his Body before the next ^{Magist} Justice at the
next Court to answer unto Jacob Gibson of a plea that he
render unto him 1139 of Tobacco

At which Court viz: the 15th day of Nov^r: Anno 1697 the
day of assize: for returne of the writ came Capt: Edward
Sedatman, High Sherif of D^e County and made returne of the
writ in these words viz: Cap: Sedatman, sheweth

On which said day the said William Evans by Michael Earle
his Attorney appeared and prayd thereof to be parolled until the
next Court which was granted the said day is given to the
pet also.

Which said cause being continued from Court to Court until
this present day and now standing for Tryal came as well the
said Pet by Richard Markham his Attorney as all for the Defonds
by his said Attorney and the pet doo take of viz:

Kent s^r. William Evans doo shew that William Evans late of Kent County
Berkshire was summoned to answer unto Jacob Gibson of
of a plea that he render unto him the summe of Eleven hundred
thirty and nine poundes of Tobacco which to him he oweth and
from him he unjustly detaineth

And whereupon the Defonds by Richard Markham his Attorney com-
plained that whereas at a Court held for Kent County the 2nd day
of Nov^r: in the Ninth Year of his Maj^{ty} King William Anno Dom 1697
