 following Copied verbatim: Woodnam Sheriff.

 appeared and prayd thereof to be passd until next Court which was  
 granted the same day is given the pet all for

Which said rap is being continued from Court to Court until this  
 present day

And now heard at this day came as well the rap by Richard  
 Marklin his Att:y for all for the said Defond: by his said Att:y  
 the said rap standing for Trial & Pet doled, viz:

Heit J: Jacob Taylor of sd County Sheriff's right Hand, Attached  
 to answer Sam: Tovey of sd County of a plea of Cross pass upon  
 the rap

And whereupon the said Sam: Tovey by Richard Marklin his  
 Att:y complains and saith that whereas the said Jacob Taylor  
 in June 1697 in said County within the Jurisdiction of this  
 Court
