if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him safe
Keep so that he haue his Body before his Majesties Justice
at the next Court to Answer unto Edward Barrowlist of
a plea the he render him 23371 of Tobacco &c.

At which Court viz: the 28th day of February anno Dom
1698 the day of Return of a Writt rained Mas: Thomas Smyth
Coroner of said County and made Return of said Writt in these
words following To wit: Tho Smyth Coroner

On which said day the said Edward Swatnam ^{Edward Swatnam} by Richard
Markley his Attor: appeared and praye therof to be parol
until the next Court which was granted the said day is
given to the plt likewise

And now heard at this day viz: 28th day of June anno Dom
1698 rained the doct: by his said Attorney now of this Court
for a Non suit for that the plt had filed no doct according
to the rules of this Court which was accordingly granted

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the Defend:
~~Edward Swatnam~~ ^{in his Capacity} doth recover from the plt Edward
Barrowlist as well the sum of fifty pounds of Tobacco
for a Non suit as also for the sum of One Hundred fifty and
eight pounds of Tobacco rest of suit
