The Sheriffs within this Province respectively shall
what pertaineth to their Office upon any former Returns
AND for setting the Horse forces That each Captⁿ of horse
in each respective County shall for the making up his Troop
elect & Enlist his Number of men out of the Inhabitants
of the said County according to such Instructions as he shall
from time to time receive from the Lord Prop^r his heirs
and Successors or his or their Lt^s for the time being
Provided always that such Troopers shall Ride their own
horses and no person shall be a Trooper unless he be owner
of A good Serviceable Horse which shall pass Muster, and that
such Troopers in consideration of their great Pay here after
to be allowed be bound and obliged to find themselves with
able and good Sufficient furniture for their horses and likewise
to find them selves with Swords, Carbine Pistols, houllets
and Ammunition and if any Trooper shall Neglect and refuse
upon Notice given in manner aforesaid to the foot to appear
at Musters at the time & place aforesaid appointed by the
Respective Captⁿ of horse accounted and Equiped as aforesaid
shall forfeit & pay the Summ of One hundred pounds of
Tobacco to the Lord Prop^r to be Levied in manner as aforesaid
for the use of the Troop for Trumpets & fiddlers and other
Necessaries as the Command^r shall think fitt and that such
Troopers for & in consideration aforesaid at all such times as
they are out a Ranging shall find their own Provision
but when in actual Service their or found Provisions
at the charge of this Province to be paid by the Publick and
if it shall happen that any Troopers horse be killed when the
Trooper to be paid by the Publick for the said horse as
not otherwise That all Justices, Deputys, Magistrates or
Constables shall in their proper persons be exempted
from being compelled to Muster or
