

in horse or foot during such terms as they officiate or bear
 such office as aforesaid Provided that this clause shall not
 extend to such persons as already have or shall hereafter
 accept of Commissions for Military Service from his Majesty
 the Lord Proprietor or his Ex^{ty} Gen^l for the time being. So as to
 Discharge such persons from their Respective charges mentioned
 in such their several & Respective Commissions, Neither shall
 this clause nor any part thereof be construed or taken to
 Exempt any Deputie, Maystrale, or Constable as aforesaid
 from sending into the field to Musters & training either
 horse or foot when and as often as due Notice or Summons
 shall be given as aforesaid some other person or persons
 in his or their stead & place, So provided or Equipped as aforesaid
 upon forfeiture as aforesaid **And Bee it Enacted** by
 the authority aforesaid that all Negroes and Slaves
 whosoever shall be exempted the Duty of training or any
 other Military Service That the Pay for the officers
 & Soldiers of the foot & horse aforesaid be no other
 than is hereafter mentioned and for no longer time
 than such officers & Soldiers shall be in actual Service
 (To wit) To every Major General being chief Commandant
 in the field Three Thousand pounds of Tobacco per Month
 To every Coll of foot Two Thousand pound of Tobacco per
 Month To A Major of foot Twelve hundred pound of
 Tobacco per Month, To a Captⁿ of foot One Thousand pound
 of Tobacco per Month, To a Lt of foot Seven hundred
 pound of Tobacco per Month To An Ensigne Six hundred
 pound of Tobacco per Month To A Sergeant four hundred
 pound of Tobacco per Month To A Corporall four hundred
 pound of Tobacco per Month, To A Drummer four hundred
