Souldier Three hundred pds of Tobacco p Month -  
And that Every Col of Horse have Three & Twenty  
hundred pds of Tobacco p Month, and that a Major  
of horse have fifteen hundred pds of Tobacco p Month  
and a Capt. of horse be allowed Thirteen hundred pds  
of Tobacco p Month To A Lieut of horse One Thousand  
pds of Tobacco p Month, To A Cornett Nine hundred  
pds of Tobacco p Month, To A Quarter Master of horse  
Each Seven hundred pds of Tobacco p Month, To A  
Trumpeter Seven hundred pds of Tobacco p Month -  
And to Every Private Trooper Six hundred pds of Tobacco  
p Month, and that all these rates & allowances for  
Such officers & Souldiers aforesaid shall be allowed & paid  
and no more, and that the Months before mentioned  
be accounted, computed and recorded according to the Calendar  
and not otherwise and to the Intent that when so ever  
it shall appear to the Lords Propy or his Lt Gen<sup>l</sup> or chief  
governor or his said Lt Gen<sup>l</sup> or chief Govern<sup>r</sup> & Council -  
to be necessary to raise forces for the Suppression of any  
forraigne Invasion or any Domestick Insurrection or  
Rebellion, or any warr with any Indians, that the said  
officers & Souldiers may be duly paid according to the  
proportions aforesaid and all other necessary charges & Expenses  
for the charge and Managing such warr may be duly paid  
and Discharged without which this Province cannot be Defended  
and Secured. Be it Enacted By the Honourable the Lords  
Propy by and with the advice & Consent of the upper & Lower  
houses of This present gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly & the authority of the  
same that from hence forth all such necessary charges of such  
warr & Souldiers pay as aforesaid shall be paid Discharged & pay  
by a Dutty Levy by an Equall Apportionment upon the Taxables  
of this Province by consent of the members of this Province  
by their Representatives and in their gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly & not otherwise
