

Soldier Three hundred pds of Tobaccoe & Month -
 And that Every Col. of Horse have Three & Twenty
 hundred pds of Tobaccoe & Month, and that a Major
 of horse have fifteen hundred pds of Tobaccoe & Month
 And a Capt: of horse &c allowed Thirteen hundred pds
 of Tobaccoe & Month To A Lieut: of horse One Thousand
 pds of Tobaccoe & Month, To A Cornett Nine hundred
 pds of Tobaccoe & Month, To A Quarter Master & Corp
 Each Seven hundred pds of Tobaccoe & Month, To A
 Trumpeter Seven hundred pds of Tobaccoe & Month -
 And to Every Privat: Trooper Six hundred pds of Tobaccoe
 & Month, and that all those rates & allowances for
 Such officers & Soldiers aforesaid shall be allowed & payed
 and no more, and that the Monthly Exp: for maintenance
 Be accounted, computed and reckoned according to the Calendar
 and not otherwise AND to the Intent that whenever
 it shall appear to the Lord Prop: or his Lt: Gen: or chif:
 governr or his said Lt: Gen: or chif: governr & counsell
 to be necessary to raise forces for the Suppression of any
 forraigne Invasion or any Domestick Insurrection or
 Rebellion, or any warre with any Indians, that the said
 officers & Soldiers may be dudly payed according to the
 proportions aforesd and all other necessary charges & expences
 for the charge and managing such warre may be dudly payed
 and Discharged without which this Province canot be defendt
 and securid, See it Enacted By the Re: Honourable the Lord
 Prop: by and with the advice & consent of the upper & lower
 houses of this present Genl Assembly & the authority of the
 same that from henceforth all such necessary charges of such
 Warre & Soldiers pay as aforesaid shall be payed Discharged & payed
 by a Just & ready by an equal Assessment upon the Inhabitants
 of this Province by consent of the majoritie of this Province
 by their Representatives and in a Just & sufficient & not otherwise
