

Souldiers of Tobacco, and such Free Masters who shall be
 Nominated & appointed as aforesaid by such Except as aforesaid to
 him or them Directed and shall thereupon be just or Neglect
 to Serve and Truly and truly to Execute and performe the said place
 and office of prest Master, shall for his & pay into the R^l Hon^{ble}
 the Lord Prop^r for every time he or they soe Nominated & appointed
 as aforesaid shall refuse or Neglect to Serve as aforesaid, the
 Summe of five hundred pounds of Tobacco, and for the more and
 better Encouragmt of such Souldiers as shall in time of Warre
 venture in the Service of the Country and Defense thereof Agst
 any Indians **See it Enacted** by the authority aforesaid, that the
 five Booty, Prize, Pillage or Plunder or any Indian, taken Prisoner
 shall by the Commander be Equally Distributed and Divided Amongst
 the Souldiers by a Division and Distribution to be made by the Poll
and for the Encouragmt of such Souldiers as shall adventure
 their Lives in the Service and Defense of the Province and for
 a Provision of some reasonable portion to be for the future
 allotted on such Souldiers as shall happen to be maimed and rendered
 incapable to get a Livelihood for themselves & families **See it**
Enacted by the authority aforesaid that every person that shall
 Adventure as a Souldier in any Warre in Defense of this Province
 and shall therein happen to be maimed or receive hurt soe as he
 thereby be rendered incapable of getting a Livelihood as aforesaid
 shall according to his disability receive a yearly Portion to be
 raised out of the Publick Treasury of this Province, for the time
 of such his Disability and every person slain in the Service
 of the Province and leaving behind him a wife & children, such
 wife & children shall also be allowed a Compensatiⁿ portion, the
 wife during her widowhood, and the children till they be of years
 able to get their Livings or be put out Apprentices and that
 this portion be yearly paid and allowed out of the fifty Thousand
 pd of Tobacco & annum to be raised by the R^l Hon^{ble} the Lord
 Prop^r or his R^l Gen^l and Council as in this act is after words
 in the Intervalles of Assembly, the pty Petitioning for such
