

This Indenture made at 25 day of Junij in the year of their majesties Right King of me & Queen Mary by y^e grace of god King & Queen of England Scotland France & Ireland & on & between Anthony Workman & Joan his wife of Kent foundry in y^e province of Maryland planters of y^e one part & John Olson of y^e same place planter of y^e other part both both that y^e Anthony Workman & Joan his wife for & in consideration of sum of six thousand pounds of self & a cause so thon in hand paid before y^e sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof y^e both Anthony Workman both acknowledge himselfe therewith fully satisfied consoned paid & thon of y^e every part & parcel therof doth fully clearly & absolutely exonerate acquit & discharge y^e to John Olson his heirs executors administrators or assignes for ever by these presents hath given granted bargained & sold alienated enfofled & confirmed & by these presents both fully clearly & absolutely give grant Bargain will alienate enfofle & conform unto y^e to John Olson his heirs executors administrators or assignes all that parcell or tract of land called Coopers quarter lying upon Kent Island at y^e head of a branch called Snows Branch begining at a marked oak tree & runing for breadth north by East fifty perches to a marked white oak & y^e marked white oak by a line drawn East & by south one hundred & forty perches for length & from y^e end of y^e East to y^e south line by a line drawn south by west fifty perches & from y^e end of y^e to line by a straight line drawn to y^e first bounded tree containing & now laid out for fifty acres more or less to be held of y^e manor of Balsomore together with all & singular y^e rights & benefites thereunto belonging & also all patents goods writings evidences & manuscripts touching or anyways concerning y^e premises or any part or parcell of them with all & singular y^e rights
