

This Indenture made this 25 day of August  
in the year of our Lord 1693 between John  
of Kent County in the province of Maryland of  
the one part and Griffith Jones of the same County  
of the other part witnesseth that if the said John  
for or in consideration of the sum of eleven  
thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco to  
him in hand already paid unto the said John  
done by these presents for himself his heirs  
etc the said John fully acquiesce and discharge  
him of the Griffith Jones of & from all demands  
heath granted bargained & sold to him by these presents  
both grant Bargain & sell unto him the said  
Griffith Jones his heirs & assigns for ever  
all of tract or parcel of land called Kettys  
beginning situated in Kent County afford  
on a brooke called midday brooke beginning  
at a marked tree being the second bounded  
tree of a parcel of land laid out for marks  
Spensax called Ratcliff cross standing by the  
D brooke & running from y<sup>e</sup> E oak north west  
with y<sup>e</sup> D land four hundred fifty & six  
perches to a parcel of land called Rousbys  
Recovery & from thence south three hundred  
& twenty perches & from y<sup>e</sup> end of y<sup>e</sup> south  
line East three hundred & twenty perches to  
the first bounded tree containing & now  
laid out for three hundred & twenty acres  
more or less as by y<sup>e</sup> patent of y<sup>e</sup> D land doth  
appear with all its rights jurisdictions and  
appertances to y<sup>e</sup> D land belonging or anyway  
pertaining Royal mines only excepted to  
have and to hold y<sup>e</sup> D land & all & every  
other of premises with y<sup>e</sup> appurtenances & every  
part of parcel thereof unto y<sup>e</sup> D Griffith Jones his  
heirs & assigns to y<sup>e</sup> only proper use & behoof of  
him y<sup>e</sup> D Griffith Jones his heirs & assigns forever  
and y<sup>e</sup> D John witnesseth for himself his heirs
