Point. The price of tuition is only thirty two dollars per annum, for instruction in all the branches we have enumerated.

The College by law is under the direction of 24 trustees, having authority to fill up vacancies in their own body. The Governor of the State is ex-officio Chancellor of the Institution.

St. Mary's College, in the city of Baltimore, was originally established by, and appropriated for the education of Catholics, but has subsequently been opened to persons of all denominations, and is a seminary of considerable reputation.

Baltimore College, for which a building has been erected in that city, and an act of incorporation granted, has not as yet obtained any considerable degree of eminence, but is im-

proving.

Washington College, situated in Kent county, was destroyed by fire a few years since, as was also Cokesbury College established in Harford County by the Methodist Society some years since.
