

To the State Roads Commission, for the use of Baltimore City, being a sum equal to one-fifth of the State Road Bonds to be issued in 1923 to be paid from the receipts of the Motor Vehicle Department.. 330,000.00

To the following Ferry Companies, for the maintenance of their respective services, computed on the mileage of each at the rate of \$1,000.00 per mile, to be expended under the direction of the State Roads Commission, and to be paid from the receipts of the Motor Vehicle Department:

To the Maryland Training School for Boys, for salaries and expenses, under the direction of the Governor, to be paid from Special Funds 10,000.00
