SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1st, 1922.

CHAPTER 518.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 694 of the Acts of 1920, entitled "An Act to provide for the appointment of a Justice of the Peace for Montgomery County, at large, and define the duties, powers, authority and jurisdiction of said Justice and other Justices of said Montgomery County, Maryland," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Chapter 694 of the Acts of 1920, entitled "An Act to provide for the appointment of a Justice of the Peace for Montgomery County, at large, and define the duties, powers, authority and jurisdiction of said Justice and other Justices of said Montgomery County," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

SEC. 1a. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed by and with the advice and consent of the Senate of the State of Maryland, if in session and without the consent and approval of the Senate if not in session, to biennially appoint a Justice of the Peace for Montgomery County, at large, and to designate said Justice of the Peace, appointed by the provisions of this Act as Police Justice.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That said Police Justice shall be a resident of the County of Montgomery, in the State of Maryland, and who, before he acts as such shall give bond to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of one thousand dollars, with a surety or sureties to be approved by the County Commissioners of said Montgomery County, conditioned that he will well and faithfully execute the duties and obligations of Justice of the Peace, and that he will account for and pay over to the County Commissioners of said county all fines, penalties, forfeitures and costs imposed by him, which he shall receive for or on ac-
