

Section 329A. It shall be unlawful for any minister of the Gospel, or other person who, under the laws of the State of Maryland, is now or may hereafter be authorized to perform the marriage ceremony, to give either directly or indirectly, or offer to give any money, present or reward, to any hotel or railroad porter, or to any other person or persons, as an inducement to said hotel or railroad porter, or other person or persons, to bring, take or direct any person or persons contemplating matrimony to said minister of the Gospel or other person so authorized to perform said rite or ceremony. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each offense.

CHAPTER 111.

AN ACT to exempt for a period of two years all the property, real and personal, of the Washington, Brandywine and Point Look Out Railroad Company from county and local taxation in Prince George's, St. Mary's and Charles Counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all the property, real and personal, of the Washington, Brandywine and Point Look Out Railroad Company shall be exempt for a period of two years, from all county and local taxation in Prince George's, St. Mary's and Charles Counties.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1922.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 350, 351, 352, 356, 366, 368, 370 and 451 of Article Eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Frederick," as codified
