

to the highest bidder for cash, but the right is reserved to reject any and all bids.

SEC. 4. That for the purpose of redeeming said bonds at maturity and for the purpose of securing prompt payment of the interest thereon, the Mayor and Council of Easton shall levy annually upon the assessable property of the town such sums as may be necessary to pay interest on said bonds semi-annually, and to redeem One thousand (\$1,000) dollars of said bonds annually beginning July 1, 1927, as aforesaid.

SEC. 5. That all provisions of the charter of Easton contrary to the intent and purpose of this Act are hereby repealed for the purposes of this Act, and in so far as they are inconsistent herewith.

SEC. 6. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall become operative and effective from the date of its approval by a majority of the votes of the legal voters of the town of Easton cast thereon at an election to be held in the town of Easton as hereinafter provided, and shall not become operative unless so approved.

SEC. 7. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall be submitted to the legal voters of the town of Easton for their approval or disapproval at the regular election to be held in the town of Easton on the first Monday in May in the year 1922; a copy of this Act and notice of its submission to the voters of Easton shall be published once a week for two weeks prior to said election in two weekly papers published in said town of Easton; the ballots to be voted at said election shall have a brief reference to or explanation of this Act printed thereon and under the same shall be provided two lines in which the voters may mark their approval or disapproval by a cross-mark in the square opposite the line desired, viz:

For improvement loan of 1922

Against improvement loan of 1922

If at such election a majority of the voters who vote upon said Act shall vote for the same then it shall at once go into effect; but if a majority of said voters vote against the same then it shall not go into effect or become operative.

SEC. 8. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the im-
