SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after the first day of June, 1922.

CHAPTER 337.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 26A of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as said section was enacted by Chapter 153 of the Acts of 1920, decreasing the compensation of the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 26A of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as said section was enacted by Chapter 153 of the Acts of 1920, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

26A. The County Commissioners of St. Mary's County shall receive a salary of three hundred (\$300) dollars per year each, including mileage.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That nothing in this Act shall affect the compensation of the present County Commissioners during their present respective terms of office.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1922.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Allegany County," to be under sub-title "Building and Building Permits," said new section to be known as Section 22A, to follow immediately after Section 22 of said Article, requiring a permit for the
