

Third—For the refurnishing or repairing of furniture in the Court room and library.

Fourth—The balance, if any, shall, annually, be paid to the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County to reimburse them for money advanced under said Chapter 14 of the Acts of 1918; provided, that from any money in hand not needed for these purposes the resident Judge of said Circuit Court is authorized to pay to the Crier of said Court a sum per month, not exceeding twenty dollars for services in attending to said Library.

CHAPTER 354.

AN ACT to authorize the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City to reinstate John P. Ward as a member of the Baltimore Police Department.

WHEREAS, John P. Ward was appointed a member of the Police Department of Baltimore City on May 8th, 1913; and,

WHEREAS, The said John P. Ward resigned from the said Police Department of Baltimore City to engage in war work on September 1st, 1918; and,

WHEREAS, The said John P. Ward desires to be reinstated in the said Police Department of Baltimore City, but because he is now thirty-six years of age he is ineligible for reinstatement under the present laws governing the appointment of members of the Police Department of Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City be and he is hereby authorized and empowered, in his discretion, to reinstate John P. Ward as a member of the Police Department of Baltimore City in the same grade occupied by him at the time of his resignation therefrom.

CHAPTER 355.

AN ACT to add a new section relating to gas and electrical corporations to Chapter 180 of the Acts of the General As-
