

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to hunt, kill or pursue any wild turkey in Garrett County, Maryland, from June 1, 1922, until the 10th day of November, 1924, after which date the open season for killing wild turkeys in Garrett County, Maryland, shall extend from November 10th to December 24th of each year, between which dates any person or persons holding a proper hunting license may shoot or kill two wild turkeys only during any one open season for hunting same; provided, however, that it shall be unlawful for any one person to shoot, kill or have in possession more than one wild turkey during any one day of the open season above provided for.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That anyone found guilty of violation any of the provisions of this Act before any justice of the peace of Garrett County or the Circuit Court of Garrett County, shall be fined the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) or shall be confined in the Garrett County jail for a period of from thirty to sixty days for each and every offense.

SEC. 3 *And be it further enacted,* That one-half of the above fine shall be paid to the informer and the remaining one-half shall be paid to the State Game Department to be credited to the "Game Protection Fund." All Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1922.

CHAPTER 418.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 11 of Article 5 of Bagby's Annotated Code of Public Civil Laws of Maryland, title "Appeals and Errors," sub-title "Appeals from Courts of Law."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 11 of Article 5 of Bagby's Annotated Code of the Public Civil Laws of Maryland, title "Appeals and Errors," sub-title "Appeals from Courts of Law," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:
