On the back of the preceding Indultm. was ordered as follows viz. A true bill by Ed. Pearce

And the said Ann Ward for a proper person Comer and Saith that she cannot gainsay the Indultm. and so as against her brought in but that she is guilty of the premises above upon her Indultm. by permitting a Negroe person to have carnal knowledge of her body and to begett a bastard Muttato Child in by the said Indultment it is alleged and therefore Submitts to the Court Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here to wit at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the second day of March Anno D. 1729 two hundred and twenty nine That the said Ann Ward being a Servant as aforesaid shall finish her time of Service and then shall serve to the use of this said County for and during the time and term of seven years as a punishment for committing the offence and according to Act of Assembly in such Case lately made and provided and also pay the sum of two hundred and four pounds of Tob. Cost accruing on the premises and to the officers of this Court

and by the Court that she be sold up to the Court a Slave at the expiration of her time

ordered by the Court here that the said Muttato Child that was delivered of the said Ann Ward be sold. On which came into Court Mr Joseph Young of said County and Saith he will pay the County for the said Child four hundred lbs of Tobacco on which the Court sells the same up till it arrives at the age of thirty one year

ordered by the Court here that the said Muttato Child that was delivered of Elizabeth Carr as by the Judgment in fo 107 may appear be sold. On which came into Court Christopher Saloman Junr. of said County and Saith he will pay the County for the said Child four hundred pounds of Tobacco on which the Court sells the same until it arrives at the age of thirty one years
