and by Robert Dunn therefor man at so say therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit the same day and Year last mentioned that the said Bartholomew Winghamam stand in the pillory for the space of halfe an hour and afterwards to receive at the publick whipping

with twenty Lashes well laid on his bare back till the blood appear as a punishment for the said Crime of Committing the Felony and according to the force form and effect of the Verdict of the Jurors and also it is considered that the said Bartholomew Winghamam pay the sume of four hundred pounds of Tobacco it being that part adjudged to pay of the four fold of the goods and stolen being halfe and also pay the sume of six hundred and eighty pound of Tobacco left accruing on the premises and to the officers of this Court.

It is also considered by the Court here at this day to wit the day & Year last mentioned that the Sheriff of Kent County take the said Bartholomew Winghamam into his Custody & execute the punishment in the Judgment and specified and afterwards to bring him into Court againe of which said Sheriff the said Sheriff to wit Joseph Young Gent. High Sheriff of Kent County make return on the day and Year last said that he hath executed the said Judgment and also hath here the said Bartholomew Winghamam before the Court
