And the said Elizabeth Jewells in her Answer to the said Indictment says that she cannot gainsay the Indictment as to what is against her brought nor that she is guilty of the promise above upon her imposed as by the said Indictment it is alledged and there upon Submits to the Court. Wherefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit of the Court House in the Town of Chest. in said County on the third day of June being the sixteenth day of said Month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty that the said Elizabeth Jewells receive at the public whipping post on her bare back of said County well laid on both sides blood as a punishment for committing the Crime of fornication and also pay the Sum of two hundred and seventy three pounds of Tobacco Cash accruing on the promise aforesaid to the

Officers of this Court  
It is also considered by the Court here to wit the same day & year last mentioned that the Sheriff of Kent County take the said Elizabeth Jewells into his custody and execute the punishment in the Indictment aforesaid and afterwards to bring her into Court againe. Off which said precept the said Sheriff to wit Joseph Young Gent Sheriff of Kent County makes return on the day and year last mentioned that he hath executed the punishment in the Indictment aforesaid and also hath here ready the said Elizabeth Jewells

Ordered by the Court here that the said Elizabeth Jewells serve for trouble & the said Elizabeth Jewells to serve at the expiration of her usual service to her Master four Months it being for trouble & loss of time disgrace and charge in law lying in. And that her Master deliver her up at expiration of the same time to the Court as then

All a assault being committed in the Court House Yard before some of the Justices by the said Jules the Sheriff of Kent County to wit Joseph Young is ordered to bring the same Jules immediately before the Court to answer the same Thereupon afterwards

the Sheriff came and made return of his said warrant Indent Copi and that he had the said Jules Gresham before the Court and the said Jules in his proper person appeared before the Court and the Court orders that the same Jules enter into Recognizance for his appearance and good behav. at any time during this Courts sitting

And the said Jules Gresham in his proper person her present in Court comes and acknowledges himselfe Indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor in the Sum of four hundred and thirty pounds Sterl to be levied on his body Goods Chattels Lands and Tenements — to the use of his Lord Ship's Heirs and Successors Conditionally that if he shall not appear at any time during this
