The afo Thomas Gresham entered into Recognizance this Court in the sum of some pounds to be levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to the use of his Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if he should not at any time during this Court sitting answer unto what should be objected against ^{him} on his said Lordship behalf on afo of an Assault committed at the Court House Yard ^{against a certain person the day} and that in the mean time he was to be of good behavior &c. AND now here afterword came the afo Thomas Gresham in his proper person into Court and appeared to the same Recognizance
