Loyloy George Hill John Tucker Henry Trulock Thomas Hatfield & Thomas Husband who being duly Voted by & Sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath do say That the said Buller Hall is not guilty as the Grand Jurors and by James Thomas their foreman all so say — Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit At the Court House in the Town of Choff. in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the sixteenth day of said Month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty That the said Buller Hall as to the said Indictment she go therof without day and that she be therefrom acquit according to the force form and effect of the Verdict of the Jurors aforesaid and also it is considered by the Court here that she pay the Sum of Seven hundred Ninety Seven p^{ts} of 100^{ts} Costs accruing on the premises aforesaid to the officers of this Court

Ordered by the Court here that the Sheriff of said County being present in Court keep the said Buller Hall in his Custody until the fees aforesaid shall be satisfied

That on the Eleventh day of May 1730 before W^{ch} Charles Hynson one of the Justices of this County W^{ch} Davis of Choff Town Ent into Recognizance for the said Buller Hall appearance at this Court. The said Buller Hall appears in her proper person

Ordered by the Court here that the said W^{ch} Davis's Recognizance be discharged. William Davis and his Recognizance taken in the Sum of twenty p^{ts} sh^{ds} to be for the appearance of the said Buller Hall at this Court and to answer unto what should be objected against her on her Defence both in and in the mean time she was to be of good behav^r and not to give show any cause why the same should not be discharged. This Court here discharged the same

That on the 11 June 1730 before W^{ch} James Justice John Wilson one of the Justices of this County W^{ch} Davis of Choff at this Court. The said John Wilson in his proper person aforesaid ordered by the Court here that the same Recognizance be discharged. John Wilson and his Recognizance taken in the Sum of some pounds sh^{ds} as aforesaid for the said Buller Hall in the aforesaid cause the same is by this Court here discharged

His Honor's Court Remembred that Touch Francis Gent Esq^r of the Right Honourable the Lord Prop^r that now is for the County aforesaid who for the same of property on this part present doth come here into said County Court before William Frisby Esq^r and his Associate Justices of the same County Court to wit at Choff. Town in the said County the twenty second day of June Anno Domini Seventeen hundred & thirty and for the same Lord Prop^r doth give the Court here to understand to be informed that Isabella Cook of Choff Town in the County aforesaid the wife of Sam^l Cook of the same place Taylor the twenty second day of June in the year aforesaid at the Town & County aforesaid & within the Jurisdiction of this Court with force
