And alledged that he was not ready for his Tryal And prayd that the same Indictm^t might be held
until the next Court his Cause in aid for him to prepare himself for his Tryal to which the
Court Conscorded upon his giving security for his app^r to the said Court to Answer the same.

At D^r 11/10/11 whils the afo^r Joseph Sanders in his properson came into Court and Acknowledged

his Master & Successors Conditionally that if he do not make his appearance at next Court to be held
for said County on the third Tuesday in August next ensuing to provide the said Lord Ship his Master
and Joseph Sanders and in his name Thomas Acknowledges himself Content

Ordered by the Court here that Sarah Haltonson as afo^r in the same cause was bailed for her app^r
for £10/10/11 Thomas Haltonson and her husband in his properson comes into Court and Acknowledges
himself Indebted to the Right Hon^e the Lord Proprietor in the sum of two pounds Sterl to be Levyed on his
body goods & Chattel Lands and Tenements to the use of his Said Lord Ship his Master and Successors
Conditionally that of the same Sarah Haltonson his wife Shall not appear at the next Court to be held for
said County on the third Tuesday in August next ensuing to give her word as the said Lord Ship his Master
and Joseph Sanders whoherwith the said John Macdaniel Acknowledges himself Content

Ordered by the Court here that John Macdaniel of same County plant^r ent^r into recognizance £10/10/11 in a sum
to be paid Court There^r 11/10/11 he said John Macdaniel comes into Court and in his properson
acknowledges himself Indebted to the Right Hon^e the Lord Proprietor in the sum of two pounds Sterl to be
Levyed on his body goods & Chattel Lands and Tenements Conditionally to the use of his Said Lord
Ship his Master & Successors Conditionally that of he do not appear at next Court to be held for said County to
