 appear at the next County Court to be hold at the Court House in the Town of Christ^m in said County
 on the third Tuesday in August next to answer unto the said Indebment of felony as afo^r and that
 in the mean time the said Joseph Sanders is to be of good behav^r wherewith the said Ellis
 Foulkes Acknowledges himselfe Content

 ledges himselfe Indebted to the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietor in the Sum of twenty pounds
 to be levied on his body goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship
 his honor and Successors Conditionally that if he do not make his app^r at next Court to be hold
 for said County on the third Tuesday in August next ensuing to prosecute the said Lord Ship his honor
 the said Joseph Sanders and in the same Thomas acknowledges himselfe Content

ordered by the Court here that Sarah Hatcher son as in order in the same cause was duly for her app^r
 upon Thomas Hatcher son and her husband in his proper person comes into Court and Acknowledges
 herselfe Indebted to the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietor in the Sum of five pounds to be levied on her
 body goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his honor and Successors
 Conditionally that if the said Sarah Hatcher son his wife shall not app^r at the next Court to be hold for
 said County on the third Tuesday in August next ensuing to give her Evid^{ce} in her said Lord Ship his honor
 in the said cause as the said Joseph Sanders wherewith he Acknowledges himselfe Content

ordered by the Court here that John Madecrist of same County plant^r enter into Recognizance as in order in the same Cause
 whereupon the said John Madecrist comes into Court and in his proper person
 Acknowledges himselfe Indebted to the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietor in the Sum of five pounds to be
 levied on his body goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements Conditionally to the use of his said Lord
 Ship his honor and Successors Conditionally that if he do not app^r at next Court to be hold for said County to
