 Deputy that now is for the Body of Kent County and upon  
 their Oath do present That Edmund Hogarty late of St.  
 Edmund Hogarty. Pauls Paroch in the County of Yorkman the tenth day of  
 Septemb<sup>r</sup>. Anno Dom<sup>o</sup> Seventeen hundred and thirty with force and Arms of  
 the Parish and in the County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court one  
 boll of the value of Sixty pounds of Tobacco and one leather Collar of the  
 value of ten pounds of Tobacco of the goods and Chattels of a certain  
 Thomas Husbonds then and being found then and there feloniously did steal  
 take and bear away contrary to the peace of the said Lord Deputy that now is  
 his good rule and Government and against the form of the Act of Assembly  
 in such case lately made and provided. The said Lord Deputy  
 Just William Hodging the Husbonds. The said Lord Deputy sworn before Grand  
 Jury Nov<sup>r</sup> Court 1730. and the said bill was endorsed as follows

Will the Grand Jury for the body of Kent County do find that the  
 bill Ignoramus of me Roger Hicks foreman

The said Edmund Hogarty on the Twentieth day of Sept<sup>r</sup>. Anno Dom<sup>o</sup>  
 Seventeen hundred and thirty before Philip Kennard Esq<sup>r</sup> one of the  
 Justices of this Court did into recogn<sup>o</sup> for his appearance to this Court as  
 Security. The same Edmund now at this Court appeared in his  
 prop<sup>r</sup> person and prayed his recogn<sup>o</sup> & his Sureties might be discharged  
 by the Court here that the same be discharged. The same Edmund Hogarty  
 his recognizance at the day and date in recogn<sup>o</sup> in the sum of five pounds  
 Sterl<sup>d</sup> for his appearance & good behavior to this Court to answer unto what  
 should be objected against him on his Lordships behalf. The same is by  
 this Court here discharged. Gideon Pearce of the said County Esq<sup>r</sup> did into  
 recognizance in the sum of five pounds Sterl<sup>d</sup> for appearance of the  
 said Edmund as aforesaid. The same recognizance is by this Court here  
 discharged.

Thomas Husbonds at the same time and date into recogn<sup>o</sup>  
 before the same Justice in the sum of twenty pounds Sterl<sup>d</sup> for his  
 appearance to this Court as aforesaid. The same in his prop<sup>r</sup>  
 person appeared. ordered by the Court here that his same recogn<sup>o</sup>  
 be discharged. The same Thomas Husbonds his recognizance  
 in the sum of twenty pounds Sterl<sup>d</sup> for his appearance to this Court  
 as aforesaid against the said Edmund is by this Court here discharged.
