That on the fourth day of february Anno Domini Seven  
:teen hundred & thirty Richard Hutton and William Beyer of that County  
Planters appeared before me one of the Justices of the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> Chiefe  
Justice the peace in the County and to keep assigned and acknowledged  
themselves to be severally indebted unto the same Lord property in the sum  
of ten pounds Sterling each to be made & Levied on their Several body  
Goods and Chattel Lands or Tenements for the Use of the said Lord property  
his heirs and Successors upon Condition that if the said Richard and William  
shall not make their personall appearance before the Justices of the same  
County at a Court to be hold for said County at the Court House in the Town  
of Chester in said County on the third Wednesday of March next to testify  
the truth of their knowledge in certain matters on part of the same  
Lord property to be objected against a certain Thomas Baker then  
the same Recognizance to be void the to remain in full force
