 and there to Answer all such matters & things which shall be Objected  
 against them being Suspected to have Feloniously Taken a Mare of the  
 Goods & Chattles of a Certain Linnor Middleton of the afo County & do not do so  
 without Leave of the Court that then this Recognizance to be Void Other-  
 wise to Remain in full force Taken before me one of the Lord Prop<sup>ty</sup>  
 Justices of the peace for the afo County — Geo Wilson

And now here at this Court to wit on the third Tuesday in March being the  
 sixteenth day of said Month Anno Dom<sup>o</sup> Seventeen hundred and thirty came the afo  
 George Lincoln and John Alexander and in their proper person appeared to  
 the afo Recognizance and prayd that their Surety for their appearance might  
 be discharged ordered by the Court here that the same Recognizance be  
 defid<sup>d</sup> Thereupon the same Recognizance to wit George Humberston  
 and John Layton their Surety as afo more Recognizances each be defid<sup>d</sup> as  
 afo

Be it Remembered that on the fourth day of this Instant  
 January 1730 Linnor Middleton did acknowledge himselfe  
 Debtd to the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>ty</sup> of the province afo to his heirs and  
 Successors in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to be  
 leaved on his Body Goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements. Conditionally that  
 if the afo Linnor Middleton Do make his personall appearance before the  
 Justices of his Lordships Court to be hold for the afo County on the third Tuesday of March  
 next then and there to prosecute on his Lordships Behalf a Certain Geo Lincoln of  
 the afo County Planter or Suspicion of Colony then this Recognizance to be void  
 otherwise to Remain in full force this Recognizance taken before me one of the Lord  
 Prop<sup>ty</sup> Justices of the peace for the County afo Geo Wilson
