And in the mean time he is to be of good Behaviour wherewith he acknowledges himself content

answer the same thereupon afterwards to wit the same day came the Sheriff of said County of his proper person dated Capias of J^o Goring Sheriff and the aforesaid Samuel being called came and in his proper person appeared and the Court having informed him of the base vile and scandalous words in derision of the Court. The aforesaid Sam^l Stone do was in an angry humor and that he might lett full some in regard of propriety on which he submits to the Court. The Court having heard the whole affair It is considered by the Court that the aforesaid Samuel Stoneman pay the sum of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco for his crime in offending as aforesaid Confess And also pay the sum of Twenty and five Tob^o Cost accruing to the officers of this Court on the promises aforesaid. Ordered that Surety be given for fine and Costs. Thereupon James Cadbor of Kent County Gent came into Court and Sworn that he will pay for the aforesaid Samuel Stoneman the sum of Six hundred lbs^o Tob^o it being the fine aforesaid and the sum of Twenty five lbs^o Tob^o the fees aforesaid and thereupon the same Summ^o is discharged
