and the said John Major in his proper person comes and in his proper person appears and saith that he cannot gainsay the Indictment and so as if against him be true but that he is guilty of the premises above upon him imposed as by the said Indictment it is alleged and thereupon submits to the Court. Therefore it is considered by the Court here to wit at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the fiftenth day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty one that the said John Major pay the sum of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco as a fine for his offence of committing the assault and also pay the sum of three hundred and Six pounds of Tobacco lost accruing on the premises and to the officers of this Court

Mr. Joseph Young Sheriff of New County being present in Court saith that he will pay the fine and to his Lordship the Honourable the Lord Proprietarie his also Arthur Miller of said County assumes the fees and accruing as aforesaid
